## CALL FOR PAPERS AND WORKSHOPS

**Submission date:** 1 July 2013

**PAPERS** – Theoretical or empirical papers, literature reviews, management education issues, and case studies are invited. Maximum 12 pages in length. All papers submitted will be refereed using a double blind peer review process. Accepted papers will be published in the conference proceedings. Papers must not have been previously published or presented. The Conference program will include full papers and interactive papers.

Presenters of full papers will have 15 minute timeslots, plus 5 minutes for discussion.

**WORKSHOPS** – Workshops and research symposia are invited and will have 90 minute timeslots. Presenters of workshops should submit an abstract outlining the topic and relevant issues using the template on the Conference website.

## NOTE TO AUTHORS

At least one author for each paper that is accepted for presentation at the Conference is expected to register and pay, by 14 October, and to present the paper. All costs to attend the Conference, including the registration fee, must be met by presenters.
